VIRGIL WARD
- Missouri

Virgil's "Championship Fishing" show has been a fixture in the broadcast media for numerous years. It is broadcast on over 200 radio and television stations. His show has been rated number 1 over 21 times by the Nielsen and Arbitron rating services. Virgil is a true pioneer angler and communicator of the sportfishing world.



INDUCTED 2018
Jim Grandt - Illinois

Jim Grandt has served as president of Grandt Industries, an Illinois-based outdoors equipment manufacturing, engineering and marketing firm, for 34 years. The company is best known for its American-made custom fishing rods and golf clubs. Grandt is also a supporter of countless conservation causes, including Ducks Unlimited, Pheasant Forever, Trout Unlimited, Salmon Unlimited, the Illinois Conservation Foundation, and Safari Club International, with an emphasis on programs for promoting youth involvement in conservation and the outdoors. Grandt was honored with induction to the Illinois Conservation Hall of Fame in 2016 and the Illinois Conservation Foundation presented Grandt with their Youth Conservation Award in 2015 as recognition for his leadership in youth activities.



INDUCTED 1995
TED WILLIAMS

Ted was the last .400 hitter in baseball (406 in 1941). Upon his retirement from baseball, he wanted to do the things Zone Grey had done. Therefore, he fished all over the world. Ted, while never catching a world record, has made many memorable catches. Ted was one of the earliest promoters of "catch and release." He was active in programs which introduced and promoted fishing to youngsters. Ted was active in the sport fishing industry through his many product endorsements. He was an unparalleled ambassador of sportfishing. He was known as the "Splendid Sportsman" of sportfishing.



INDUCTED 2005
CURT GOWDY

Curt started fly-fishing with his father at age 8 in the rivers of Wyoming. He started doing sports broadcasts in Cheyenne in 1943 during a local football game. He went on to be the broadcaster for the Boston Red Sox baseball team. A result of his broadcasts, he met many people who were interested in fishing. When ABC introduced "The Wide World of Sports," Curt and Joe Brooks suggested a fishing segment. The fishing segment was so well received it led to the "American Sportsman" show, which ran for 20 years.



INDUCTED 1986
JOAN WULFF

Joan's involvement in the sport of fishing began at age 10, when she convinced her father that women could not only catch fish, but also could be competitive. Joan was instrumental in introducing many women to the sport of fishing, through her development of tackle and clothing specifically designed for women. Joan has authored numerous articles and books about fly-fishing.



INDUCTED 1989
SPENCE PETROS
- Illinois

Spence's knowledge of sportfishing and writing elevated Fishing Facts magazine to one of North America's top outdoor publications. He has spent decades conducting sportfishing seminars of both an informative and entertaining nature. Spence has proven time after time that he can consistently catch fish on any lake, whether it's his first or one hundredth time on it.



MINNESOTA
INDUCTED 1986 | AL LINDNER

Al was a fishing guide who became one of this nation's most recognized fishing educators and ambassadors. He has authored numerous sportfishing "how-to" and technical books. He was co-founder and director of In-Fisherman magazine, from which the In-Fisherman radio and television shows developed. This diverse media has made his tips and techniques available to millions of anglers. Al is a highly sought after personality on the sport show trail. The Camp Fish Education Opportunities Foundation, founded by Al, still introduces countless youngsters to sportfishing. It encourages their participation in the outdoors and helps preserve the environment for all of us.



INDUCTED 2009
BOB MEHSIKOMER
- Minnesota

Bob began fishing as a youngster and developed his fishing methods to make him a successful angler. Working to share his knowledge with others, Bob began to conduct seminars and speaking engagements. Bob further promoted "Please Practice C.P.R. - Catch, Photo and Release, the Future Depends upon It." Bob is the holder of several world record catches. Bob's nationally televised program, "Simply Fishing," enjoys a large viewing audience.



INDUCTED 2006
TEDDY ROOSEVELT

Teddy was the twenty-sixth president of the United States, from 1901-1909. Through his efforts, millions of acres of western lands were acquired and added to our national forests. These were reserved for the public's use and enjoyment. Teddy enjoyed the outdoors and left a legacy of conservation minded stewardship of our natural resources.



INDUCTED 1983
CARL LOWRANCE

Carl Lowrance was an early developer of electronic depth finding for fishing. Through trial and error, Lowrance developed the magic little "red box" in 1956. This innovation has since evolved to be an instrument of great accuracy. It has developed an industry whose application of electronic depth finding is almost synonymous with sportfishing today.



INDUCTED 1980
ISAAK WALTON

A mid-1600's conservationist angler and author, Walton penned the near four-century-old fishing classic, "The Compleat Angler," which for many years was the textbook for the angler and conservationist. Often referred to as the "Father of Angling," his name was adopted as the title of the Izaak Walton League of America. It is one of the nation's leading natural resource conservation organizations.



INDUCTED 2023
Karen Eppinger - Michigan

The Eppinger tradition began in 1906 when Lou Eppinger began fishing with a lure of his own design: a spoon weighting two ounces. The metal was hammered out so that it was thinner in the middle and thicker toward the edges. By 1912, Lou turned his prototype into a finished lure, the Osprey. It caught fish; lots of them. In 1918, Lou's nephew Ed came to work in his uncle's shop. They changed the name of the Osprey to Dardelle and that name is still used for Eppinger's most successful line of lures.

In 1987, Ed's daughter, Karen, took over at the helm of Eppinger Manufacturing and has been instrumental in successfully leading the company into the 21st century. In 1994, Karen was joined by her daughter Jennifer Burdette, keeping this remarkable family-owned tradition alive. Eppinger celebrated its 100-year milestone in 2006 as the leading company and innovator of high-quality fishing lures.

Over the years, Karen filled many roles, from tying backcasts and feathers, working benches at sports shows and fishing in tournaments. She is proud that the company has always been a family business, and she's even more pleased that it continues to be based in Michigan. Eppinger Manufacturing is one of only a few manufacturers to still make their lures in the United States and according to Karen Eppinger, "We build performance, value and tradition into each and every Dardelle lure."
